Rules and Guidelines

- 1. Artists must bring their own art supplies and surfaces on which to create artwork. These may include:
 - 1. Paints, pastels, pencils
 - 2. Pallet or board for mixing paint
 - 3. Canvas
 - 4. Paint brushes
 - 5. Water and paper towels
 - 6. Standing easel
 - 7. Frame for your canvas
 - 8. Tools for framing
- 2. Sign-in at the Check-In table at the Buda Welcome Center at 303 N, Main Street between 8:00am-9:30am.
 - 1. Each competing artist will receive their identifying number label.
 - 2. Artists MUST get their blank canvas stamped before painting begins.
 - 3. The artist's entry fee can be paid at the Check-In Table or by pre-registering online.
- 3. Paint only during the painting time: 9:30am-11:30am
- 4. Artists may paint in designated locations along Main Street. See MAP.
- 5. Do NOT set up a tent unless given special permission. Consider using an easel umbrella.
- 6. At 11:30am painting stops and artwork is to be framed and brought to the Buda Welcome Center to display on the artist's easel for the Awards Judging (12:30pm-1:00pm) and Art Sale (1:00pm-5:00pm)
- 7. Paintings MUST BE framed at the time of submission.
- 8. Artists may sign the front or the back of their artwork
- Artwork will not be accepted after 12:00pm. Should a line form at the check-in desk, artists MUST be in line at or before 12:00pm.
- 10. Upon submission, artists will fill out a form with the following information:
 - 1. Artist's Name
 - 2. Title of Artwork
 - 3. Medium
 - 4. Price
- 11. All artwork submitted into the Quick Draw Competition will be exhibited and for sale on Saturday, September 16 from 12:30-5:00pm at the Buda Welcome Center.



- 12. Inspired Minds Art Center will retain a 40% commission from the sale of any artwork submitted into the Quick Draw Competition. If someone wants to buy your painting, please direct them to the Check-In Table to handle the sale.
- 13. Tax of 8.25% will apply to all sales at check out.
- 14. Unsold artwork must be picked up by at 5pm. Any artwork and easels left at the event will become the property of Inspired Minds Art Center.
- 15. Awards will be presented to the winners at the Buda Welcome Center, Saturday, September 16 at 3:00pm. Winning artwork is invited to be exhibited in the Buda Plein Air juried exhibition in the Inspired Minds Gallery, October 20–November 3, 2023.

- Mastery of the medium
- Quality of composition
- Perspective
- Meaning
- Expressiveness
