
Plein Air Competition Dates: September 12–16, 2023

Competition check-in begins at Inspired Minds Art Center on Tuesday, September 12th at 5:00pm and is available daily through 5:00pm on Friday, September 15.

Completed plein air artwork must be submitted by 9am, Saturday, Sept. 16 at the Buda Welcome Center.

All awards will be announced at the Public Awards Celebration at the Buda Welcome Center on Saturday, Sept. 16th at 3:00pm







Rules and Guidelines

- 1. Artists must bring their own art supplies and surfaces on which to create artwork.
- 2. Maximum 2D size: 36" x 36" not including frame, Maximum 3D size: 24" x 24" x 24"
- 3. All surfaces used in the Competition must be officially stamped before use at Inspired Minds Art Center, 121 Main Street. Check-in available daily between 9am-5pm.
- 4. Frames are REQUIRED for all 2D work submitted for jurying and judging.
- 5. Paintings MUST BE framed and ready to hang at the time of submission.
- 6. Entries must be created in the pure intent of outdoor, on location, plein air art. Subject matter in the artwork must be comprised of what the artist views on location. At least 80% of the artwork must be produced outdoors in the spirit of plein air in the 76810 zip code. Entries produced using manipulated photographic processes will not be accepted. If there is any concern that a larger percentage of your artwork was completed in the studio, you will be asked to provide progression snapshots of your work being completed en plein air.
- 7. Artists may only choose two (2) works to submit for awards and jurying
- 8. Artists MUST PRINT their name on the back of their artwork
- 9. Artists may sign the front or the back of their artwork
- 10.Artwork MUST BE submitted for judging between 8am-9am on September 16th at the Buda Welcome Center, 303 N. Main Street, Buda, TX. Late artwork will not be accepted.
- 11.Artists must wear identifying badges while creating. Badges will be provided in your welcome pack.
- 12.Registered artists agree to respect both private property owners by securing permission to go onto their property and public lands by following the use regulations of the various land management agencies (i.e. obtaining necessary use permits, staying on designated roads and trails, etc.).
- 13.Artists may NOT set up a tent unless given special permission. Consider using an easel umbrella.
- 14.All artwork submitted into the Plain Air Competition will be exhibited and for sale at the VIP First Look Fête on Saturday, September 16 and will be juried for entry into the Buda Plein Air Exhibit on October 20 November 3.





- 15.Inspired Minds Art Center will retain a 40% commission from the sale of any artwork submitted into the Plein Air Competition.
- 16. Tax of 8.25% will apply to all sales at check out.
- 17.Artwork may be sold off the easel, and IMAC will not take a commission on this artwork. HOWEVER, any artwork sold off the easel during the competition MAY NOT be entered into the Plein Air Competition.



Check-In And Canvas Stamping At Inspired Minds Art Center


All participating artists must check-in and have the surfaces on which they would like to create artwork stamped prior to beginning their artwork in order to participate in the competition. Check-in and canvas stamping will take place at Inspired Minds Art Center (IMAC), 121 Main Street, Buda, TX.

- You may get all surfaces you will need for the competition stamped at one time, or you
 may return to the stamping station multiple times.
- There is no limit to the number of surfaces you may have stamped.
- Artist badges and Welcome Packs including all information about the event and our supporters and fun swag will be provided at check in
- Artists will be asked to sign a waiver accepting the rules and guidelines upon check-in

- Wednesday Friday, September 13–15, 9:00am-5:00pm at IMAC





Keep In Mind

- All surfaces needed for the competition may be stamped at one time, or artists
 may return to the stamping station multiple times. There is no limit to the number
 of surfaces that can be stamped.
- Artwork in any medium other than photography is allowed.
- Artwork may be in any style (Impressionism, Realism, Abstract, etc.)
- The defined painting area is the <u>78610 zip code</u>.

Plein Air Painting Health And Safety Tips


Personal Safety


Registration Closes on <u>September 1st at 11:59pm</u>

 - *A valid student ID must be presented upon arrival for competition check-in.



- 2. The second will contain your discount code needed to save 50% off Quick Draw registration.




All winning artwork will be guaranteed inclusion in the 2023 Buda Plein Air Competition juried exhibition.
